



Hurricane Condition Alert Network (hurcon.net)

Hurricane conditions and what to do if you live on the beach:

HURCON 5: An alert that indicates surface winds in excess of 58 mph (50 knots) are forecast to arrive here within 96 hours. Make hotel reservations and go to Publix. Then head to the bar for the latest information.

HURCON 4: An alert that indicates surface winds in excess of 58 mph (50 knots) are forecast to arrive here within 72 hours. Get Gas, Grass & Cash.

HURCON 3: An alert that indicates surface winds in excess of 58 mph are forecast to arrive here within 48 hours. Pack the car and go to the hotel.

HURCON 2: An alert that indicates surface winds in excess of 58 mph are forecast to arrive within 24 hours.

HURCON 1: An alert that indicates surface winds in excess of 58 mph are forecast to arrive here within 12 hours.

HURCON 1C - Caution: Gale force winds of 40-57 mph/35-49 knots sustained are happening now. Causeways and bridges to the mainland are closed.

HURCON 1E - Emergency: Stay Inside; Dangerous winds of 58 mph/50 knots sustained and/or gusts of 69 mph/60 knots or greater are happening now.

HURCON 1R - Recovery: Destructive winds have subsided and are no longer forecast to occur; Recovery effort starts to determine the extent of the damage and to establish safe zones around hazards (e.g. downed power lines, unstable structures).

NOTE: HURCON Alert System is will be deployed in time for the 2025 season. We avoid the use of the other "H word" in conversation.
